

EN FUEGO KIDS (EFK) Player/Parent Code of Conduct

We, En Fuego Kids (EFK), have implemented this Player/Parent Code of Conduct to promote the proper role of parents in supporting their children in sports. This policy furthers our mission to assist youth in developing qualities of citizenship, discipline, teamwork, and physical well-being through proper guidance and exemplary leadership.

EFK is dedicated to providing a safe, fun atmosphere for children participating in our events, while ensuring the safety of officials, volunteers, and spectators. Parents must read, understand, and sign this form before their children participate in any of our events. Additionally, we ask that you inform any friends and relatives attending the events about our policies concerning acceptable behavior.

The core principles of character-building and ethics in sports are embodied in the values of Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring, and Good Citizenship. To ensure these values are upheld, I agree to the following:

I will remember that children participate to have fun, and that youth sports are for the children, not adults.

I will not force my child to participate in sports.

I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect my child's safety or that of others.

I will familiarize myself with the event's policies and the rules of the game.

I will prioritize the emotional and physical well-being of athletes over any personal desire for my child to win.

I (and my guests) will serve as positive role models by showing respect, courtesy, and support for all players, coaches, officials, and spectators.

I (and my guests) will refrain from unsportsmanlike conduct, including booing, taunting, yelling at officials or coaches, or using profane language or gestures.

I (and my guests) will accept all decisions made by umpires and officials as fair and made to the best of their ability.

I will not promote any behavior that could endanger the health or well-being of athletes.

I (and my guests) will respect the authority of officials during games and will not confront coaches during or immediately after games.



I agree to observe a 24-hour cooling-off period before discussing any concerns with a coach or manager.

I will teach my child to play by the rules and resolve conflicts peacefully.

I will demand that my child treats other players, coaches, officials, and spectators with respect, regardless of race, creed, color, sex, or ability.

I will teach my child that doing their best is more important than winning, so they never feel defeated by the outcome of a game.

I will praise my child for competing fairly and giving their best effort.

I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making mistakes or losing.

I will emphasize skill development and the benefits of practice over winning and de-emphasize game results.

I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games or practices unless I am an official coach and on the field or in the dugout with the players.

Agreement to Alcohol Policy and Responsibility

By attending and participating in En Fuego U events, I acknowledge that I have read and understand the Alcohol Policy posted on the website and at the concession stand. I agree to abide by the policy, which includes rules on responsible alcohol consumption and personal responsibility for actions while under the influence of alcohol.

I further agree that:

Individuals consuming alcohol are responsible for their actions.En Fuego U is not liable for any damages or incidents caused by individuals under the influence of alcohol.Violating the alcohol policy may result in removal from the event and further disciplinary action.
